



## OPTION SELECTION INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS ENTERING GRADE 11, 2021-2022



### COURSE SELECTION GUIDELINES:

1. Students must choose 8 courses. No spares are permitted in grade 11. One eLearning course per semester can be included.
2. Choose the appropriate level of study (E, O, C, M, U) for all courses and ensure that you meet the prerequisites.
3. Students who have failed a compulsory Grade 9 or 10 course should prioritize these courses.
4. ⓑ indicates a Business SHSM Major Course; ⓒ indicates a Sports SHSM Major Course
5. Hand in completed course selection form printed from myBlueprint, the Student Identification Consent Form, and the Activity fee (\$90) on Thursday February 25<sup>th</sup>.

### NOTE!!

- Physical Education and Art Courses may have an additional fee to be paid at the start of the course.
- Be sure to check the Mathways Chart to ensure you have the prerequisites:
  - MFM2P1 → MCF3M1 or MBF3C1 or MEL3E1
  - MPM2D1 → MCR3U1 or MCF3M1 or MBF3C1 or MEL3E1
  - MAT2L1 → MEL3E1
- ENRICHED COURSE REQUIREMENTS:
  - English requires a prerequisite grade of 80% in ENG2DE or ENG2D1
  - Math requires a prerequisite grade of 87% in MPM2DE or MPM2D1
  - Science courses require a prerequisite grade of 80% in SNC2DE or SNC2D1
