COURSE SELECTION GUIDELINES:

1. Students must choose 8 courses. Course descriptions can be found on myBlueprint.ca.
2. Choose the appropriate level of study (L, P, D, E, O) for all courses.
3. Students who have failed a compulsory Grade 9 course please prioritize these courses during course selection.
4. Ensure you have the course prerequisites by checking the Course Calendar on myBlueprint.ca
5. Hand in completed course selection form printed from myBlueprint, the Activity fee (\$90), and Student Identification Consent Form on Thursday, February 24th.

- **ENRICHED COURSE REQUIREMENTS:**
 - **English** and **History** require a pre-requisite grade of 80% in ENG1D1 or ENG1DE
 - **Math** requires a pre-requisite grade of 85% in MTH1W1 or MTH1WE
 - **Science** requires a pre-requisite grade of 80% in SNC1D1 or SNC1DE
