3. Students who have failed a compulsory Grade 9 or 10 course should prioritize these courses.
4. (B) indicates a Business SHSM Major Course; (S) indicates a Sports SHSM Major Course
5. Hand in completed course selection form printed from myBlueprint, the Student Identification Consent Form, and the Activity fee ( $\$ 90$ ) on Thursday February $24^{\text {th }}$.
