

OPTION SELECTION INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS ENTERING GRADE 11, 2022-2023



COURSE SELECTION GUIDELINES:

- 1. Students must choose 8 courses. No spares are permitted in grade 11. One elearning course per semester can be included.
- 2. Choose the appropriate level of study (E, O, C, M, U) for all courses and ensure that you meet the prerequisites.
- 3. Students who have failed a compulsory Grade 9 or 10 course should prioritize these courses.
- 4. B indicates a Business SHSM Major Course; S indicates a Sports SHSM Major Course
- 5. Hand in completed course selection form printed from myBlueprint, the Student Identification Consent Form, and the Activity fee (\$90) on Thursday February 24th.

NOTE!!

- Physical Education and Art Courses may have an additional fee to be paid at the start of the course.
- Be sure to check the Mathways Chart to ensure you have the prerequisites:
 - MFM2P1 → MCF3M1 or MBF3C1 or MEL3E1
 - MPM2D1 → MCR3U1 or MCF3M1 or MBF3C1 or MEL3E1
 - MAT2L1 → MEL3E1
- ENRICHED COURSE REQUIREMENTS:
 - English requires a prerequisite grade of 80% in ENG2DE or ENG2D1
 - Math requires a prerequisite grade of 87% in MPM2DE or MPM2D1
 - Science courses require a prerequisite grade of 80% in SNC2DE or SNC2D1
